Board considered the target to have 100% of courses online by 2021, including how this would impact upon 'contact time', the experience of the learner and the role of the learning professional. It was noted that the aim would be to allow more time for practice and 'soft skill' development, rather than reducing contact time. The Board considered whether the target was appropriate in light of the cost to the business; it was noted that learners expect a high quality online experience
